## Green Street Program Objectives

The Green Street Mens residential program provides a supportive environment that encourages participants to gain confidence in self sustainability and independent living. It is the program's priority to provide tools to help people re-enter society as sober, productive, independent contributing members.

These tools are provided through vocational training, work ready programs, life skills groups, and individual counseling.



## Services Available

Participants are assigned a primary counselor upon admission. Throughout the Green Street program participants are encouraged to engage in the following:

- Outpatient Treatment
- Life Skills Groups
- Alternative to violence program
- De-escalation training
- HIV/AIDS presentations
- Vocation Programs (Required upon admission)

The Green Street program is designed and structured to enhance community participation which affords each person increased social functioning.

## Community Residence Living

121 Green Street has 28 beds. The average length of stay is 6 to 9 months. Residents experience community style living with shared sleeping quarters dining, and recreation space.

This community living style is encouraged with community dinners each night, community forums, and life skills groups. Participants must be 18 years of age or older. Syracuse Behavioral Healthcare staff are on site 24 hours a day.

## Green Street Serves

Men who meet the following criteria:

- Chemical Dependency
- Homeless or living in an environment not conducive to recovery
- Need outpatient treatment and/or case management and other supportive services
