The women's halfway house was first licensed in 1969 in the community of Syracuse and is still the leading rehabilitation residential program for women in upstate New York.

The Harriet May Mills House is named after a pioneer suffragist, the first female to run for statewide office in New York. This house is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and Syracuse Behavioral Healthcare is proud to continue the legacy and integrity of the house today.

Harriet May Mills House Serves:

Harriet May Mills provides stable housing, rehabilitation, and education for 12 homeless women with chemical dependency. This house is dedicated to women entering the transitional phase of recovery from addiction and homelessness.



Community Residence Living:

The Harriet May Mills community residence is located about a mile from downtown Syracuse, right on the bus line. Residents travel to outpatient treatment and support services during the day and return to the residence to share dinner as a community. There is a common kitchen, living room, dining room, sitting area and several bathrooms. There are six bedrooms, each accommodating two residents. One of the bedrooms is handicapped accessible and has a private bath. Residents are encouraged to remain at the facility at least six months, but may stay up to a year, prior to transitioning back into the community. The residence is staffed 24 hours a day.

Harriet May Mills House provides a supportive environment that allows participants to gain confidence in self sustainability and independent living. It is the program's priority to provide tools to women in order to re-enter into society as productive, independent members.

SBH will assist residents in addressing their chemical dependency symptoms to promote healthy and balanced lifestyles. In addition to critical housing recovery services, the Harriet May Mills house offers a full program of Living Skills Trainings.
