Lincoln House Program Objectives

The Lincoln House Men's residential program provides a supportive environment that encourages participants to gain confidence in self-sustainability and independent living. It is the program's priority to provide tools to help people re-enter society as productive, independent contributing members.

These tools are provided through vocational training, work ready programs, life skills groups, and individual counseling.

Services Available

Participants are assigned a primary counselor upon admission. Throughout the Lincoln House program participants are encouraged to engage in the following:

- Education
- Outpatient Treatment
- Life Skills Groups
- De-escalation training
- HIV/AIDS presentations
- Vocational Programs (Required upon admission)
- Case management

The Lincoln House program is designed and structured to enhance community participation which affords each person increased social functioning.

Community Residence Living

Lincoln House capacity is 30 men. The average length of stay is six to nine months. Residents experience private sleeping quarters with shared dining and recreation space.

This supportive living style is encouraged with community dinners each night, community forums, and life skills groups. Participants must be 18 years of age or older. Syracuse Behavioral Healthcare staff are on site 24 hours a day.

Lincoln House Serves

The Lincoln House Men's Residence in Syracuse, NY provides transitional living to men who meet the following criteria:

- Chemical Dependency
- Living in an environment not conducive to recovery
- Need outpatient treatment and/or case management and other supportive services
